The Chapel and Almshouses (originally the Hospital), date back to the 12th century. We strengthened the unsupported Hospital gable, replaced the boundary wall, and replaced all of the damaging cement render and pointing with lime. The site is a Listed Building and Scheduled Monument, and is a much loved and visited site which we were delighted to help bring back into use, including helping to raise the necessary funds from multiple donors.
